Carlo Bettocchi was born in Rome (Italy) and is Urologist since 1994 and Chief of the Centre of Urological Andrology at the Polyclinic Hospital of the University of Bari, Italy, since 1996. His research career has included positions in the urology department (with R. Janknegt) of the Academic Hospital of Maastricht, the Netherlands (1991); the uro-andrology department (with J.P. Pryor and D.J. Ralph) of the Middlesex Hospital UCLH, UK (1992-1995 and from 2004 to nowadays); and King's College Hospital (also with J.P. Pryor) in London, UK (1992-1995). Dr Bettocchi is author of more than 100 publications and chapters in national and international journals and books, and he has been an investigator on several protocols in the field of uroandrology. He is secretary of the Italian National Observatory on Gender Dysphoria (ONIG), member of the executive committee of both European Society of Sexual Medicine (ESSM) and Andrological Section of the European Association of Urology (ESAU). Since 2004, Dr Bettocchi is also Honorary Senior Lecturer of the University College London Hospital NHS Trust (UK) and member of the scientific committee of the Italian Society of Andrology (SIA) and is further involved as a member of several other scientific societies. He is actually member of the Editorial Review Board of the American Journal of Men's Health and reviewer of several national and international journals. His main research interests and clinical activities are in the areas of erectile and sexual dysfunction, male infertility and gender dysphoria.
